How to install and configure the component

1. Download the component and plugin

Go to the website <http://www.onnogroen.nl/webee/> and download the latest version of the WebeeComment component and plugin.

2. Install the component

In the Joomla! backend, go to the Extensions tab and choose for Install/Uninstall.

Browse your computer and select the component zip file.

Install the component. You should now see the follow message:



3. Install the plugin

In the Joomla! backend, go to the Extensions tab and choose for Install/Uninstall.

Browse your computer and select the plugin zip file.


Install the plugin. You should now see the follow message:



Do not forget to enable the plugin in the Plugin Manager.

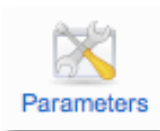
4. Parameters of the component

In the Joomla! backend, go to the Components tab and click the Webeee Comments button.



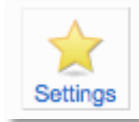

5. Configuration of the component

In the Joomla! backend, go to the Components tab click the Webee Comment menu item. In the overview, click on the "Settings" button on the top right.



You should now see this overview (can differ):

Press the disable button to disable comments for that specific section/category. Repeat this step for each section/category.

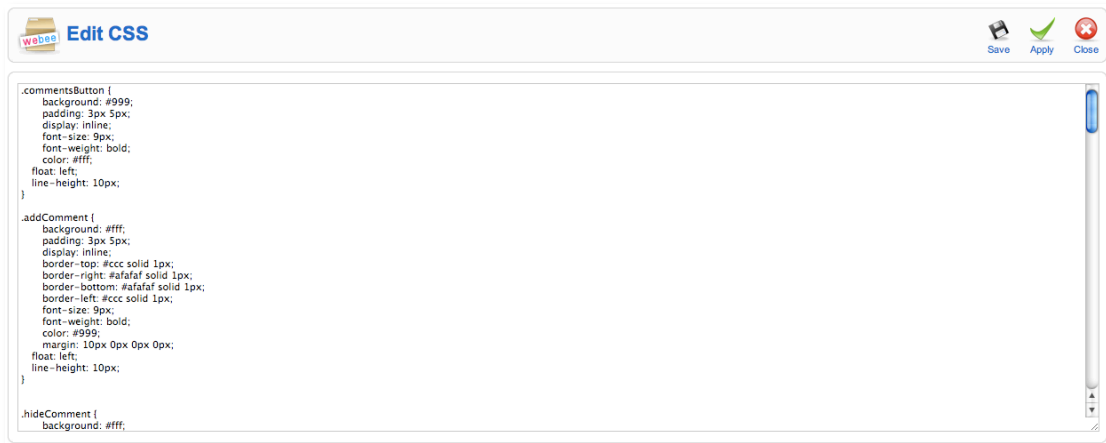
The default setting for each section/category/article is **Enabled**.

6. Edit CSS

In the Joomla! backend, go to the Components tab and click on the Webee Comment menu item. Click the "Edit CSS" button in the top right.



You should now see this overview (can differ):



Edit the CSS and press the "Save" or "Apply" button at the top right of the screen.
